4. How would you know that a child is physically ready for Year 1 at the end of EYFS?

1) Explain what children in EYFS learn in their PE curriculum

Talk through the curriculum long-term plan again. Mention how the curriculum is different in KS1 & KS2.

2) Explain what opportunities children in EYFS have to be physically active

Explain how children are given regular access to outside areas and are encouraged to be regularly active. Does the EYFS staff ever do any active Literacy or Maths lessons?

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3) Do you assess children in EYFS differently from children in KS1 and KS2?

Explain your school-specific assessment for EYFS (for example, Tapestry)

4) How would you know that a child is physically ready for Year 1 at the end of EYFS?

Talk about the development of physical skills, such as how children can move and if they are secure at moving forwards and in other different ways. Talk about developing their gross and fine motor skills and the children being at GLD.
