In a 2022 Ofsted Inspection, the following questions were asked about the school's leadership in PE

1. What monitoring is in place across the school for PE to ensure high-quality learning?
2. What CPD have you had?
3. What CPD have other staff had, and what plans have you got in place to provide CPD?
4. What impact has any CPD had on staff, and what did the CPD look like?
5. Are your SLT and Governors aware of learning in PE and how you teach this subject?
6. Do you have a PE advocate on the Board of Governors for PE?
7. How do you intend to lead PE for the rest of the academic year?

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1) What monitoring is in place across the school for PE to ensure high-quality learning?

Talk about any lesson observations you have conducted and if you have been observed yourself by SLT. You can show the inspector evidence of these if you have it. Talk about any pupil voice you have conducted and any staff meeting delivered with PE.

2) What CPD have you had?

Be honest; if you haven't had any PE CPD, talk about CPD you would like in the future.

3) What CPD have other staff had, and what plans have you got in place to provide CPD?

The inspector will check this with the teaching staff so make sure they remember any PE training they have had!

4) What impact has any CPD had on staff, and what did the CPD look like?

Explain the outcomes of the CPD provided and how that has benefited the children.

5) Are your SLT and Governors aware of learning in PE and how you teach this subject?

Talk about staff meetings, subject reviews, and any governor reports. Have evidence of these if you have produced anything.

6) Do you have a PE advocate on the Board of Governors for PE?

If you haven't got one, ask for one! You should have a governor responsible for PESSP spending, so it is easily linked.

7) How do you intend to lead PE for the rest of the academic year?

Again talk through your action plan and how you want to develop the subject. This can be a good chance to talk about future extracurricular events and sports days.
